(1) CSR budget of FY 2023-24 is about Rs 84 Crs. Modalities of utilization of funds and implementation schedules for the projects: PLL's CSR funds will be utilized as per the guidelines laid down in PLL CSR Policy. Projects shall be implemented on milestone basis.

(3) Details of need and impact assessment, if any, for the projects undertaken by the company: CSR Projects shall be conceptualized/ implemented based on the need of the stakeholders and Impact assessment of CSR projects having outlay of Rs.1 crore or more shall be carried out through an independent agency in line with Companies Act, 2013, CSR Rules and amendments thereof.

(4) The above action plan is indicative subject to availability of suitable projects. Approvals shall be put up before competent authority during the financial year. PLL has developed a focused approach to enhance access to quality healthcare and skill / education facilities to enrich the lives of communities in need across the Country. PLL shall continue to work with Government agencies and other credible NGOs / implementation partners to enhance the outreach of its CSR initiatives.
