

'48% people got medical care before death in 2018'

It's 8.6 Percentage Points More Than In 2013: Survey

New Delhi: More people received medical care before death in 2018 as compared to five years ago, the Sample Registration System Statistical Report 2018, released on Friday, said.

The data showed there was an increase of about 8.6 percentage points where the deceased had received medical attention before death in hospitals during 2013-2018.

In 2018, in nearly 48% deaths, the deceased had received medical attention either at a government hospital or a private hospital. While nearly

50% of them got institutional care, around 20% were attended by untrained functionaries. In rural areas, more than 23% were attended to by untrained functionaries, whereas in urban settings, this was much lower at 8.7%, the data released by the Registrar General

of India showed. In 2018, more such people were received at government hospitals as compared to private ones. Government hospitals got 29.4% of such cases, whereas 18.5% deaths where deceased got medical care were in private hospitals.

2 dead, 4 in hosp after gas leak in Vizag unit

Visakhapatnam: In the second incident of a fatal gas leak at an industrial unit in Visakhapatnam in less than two months, two people died and four others were hospitalised on Monday after hydrogen sulphide leaked from a reactor at Sainor Life Sciences Private Ltd (SLSP). Both victims were employees of the company, which operates from Jawaharlal

Nehru Pharma City at Parwada on the outskirts of the city.

Although SLSP insisted that the leak was contained in the unit, there was some panic in Parwada as people could smell the pungent gas. Police said R Narendran, 33, and M Gowri Shankar, 26, died. The injured — LV Chandrasekhar, P Anand Babu, D Janaki Rao and M Suryanarayana — were admitted to a private hospital.

47 goats quarantined after goatherd tests Covid +ve in Karnataka village

Bengaluru: Forty-seven goats were quarantined on Tuesday after a goatherd tested positive for Covid-19 in Godekere village

in Tumakuru district, about 127km from Bengaluru.

Sources said the village in Chikkanyakanahalli taluk has around 300 houses and a population of 1,000. Two villagers, including the goatherd, tested

positive recently. After this, four goats of the goat-rearer died, causing alarm in the village.

District health and veterinary officials visited the village on Tuesday and collected swab samples of the goats before putting

the livestock in quarantine outside the village. The team faced huge resistance from the villagers, who suspected they had arrived to cull the goats.

The officials convinced them that there is risk of the livestock

getting infected by coronavirus and have to be tested.

P Manivannan, secretary of the animal husbandry department, said they will look into the matter and postmortem will be conducted on the dead goats.
